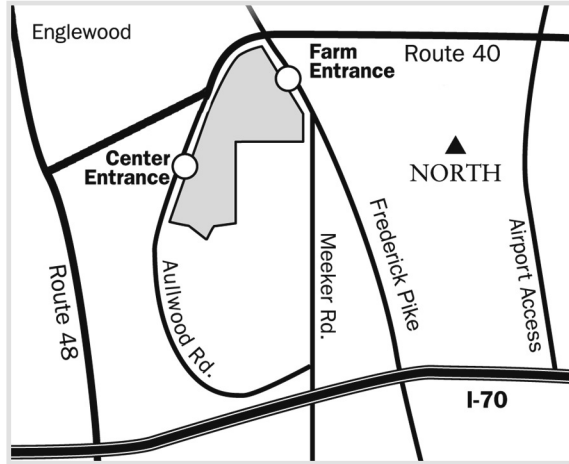


# Coming to Aullwood

Aullwood is only twenty minutes from downtown Dayton and a five-minute drive from the Dayton airport.



## Directions:

From I-70, take Airport Access Rd. exit 32. After about a mile and a half, take the US-40 exit toward Englewood/Vandalia. Turn left on W. National Rd. (US-40). To reach the farm, turn left on Frederick Pike; the farm will be on your right. To reach the center, turn left on Aullwood Road; the center will be on your left.

*Meets requirements 1- 4, part of 5.*

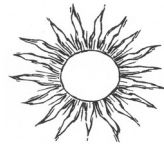
## Camper Badge
