



Aullwood's natural legacy

Aullwood is a treasure in southwest Ohio. Marie S. Aull presented an unprecedented gift to the National Audubon Society in 1957—a beautiful wildlife sanctuary and one of the Midwest's first nature centers. Today Aullwood's 200-acre sanctuary includes six miles of walking trails winding through prairie, woods, ponds, farmland and meadows.

Aullwood's Marie S. Aull Education Center is filled with dozens of hands-on exhibits in two discovery rooms; countless opportunities to explore rich natural resources in six thematic classrooms; and places for quiet reflection in observation rooms. A 150-seat auditorium provides space for meetings, conferences, receptions and other community events.

At Aullwood's sustainable farm, visitors explore the century-old bank barn which is home to pigs, horses, goats and other livestock. The Charity A. Krueger Farm Discovery Center features interactive exhibits, a farm classroom, a 176-seat auditorium and the country's first Head Start Nature/Farm Preschool that is located on a working farm. Visitors may explore colorful herb and vegetable gardens, spring house, pond, sugar house and croplands.

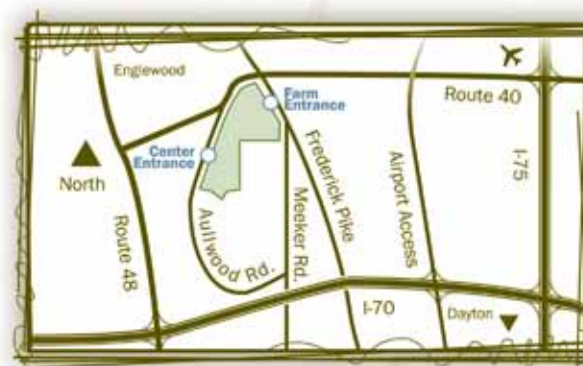

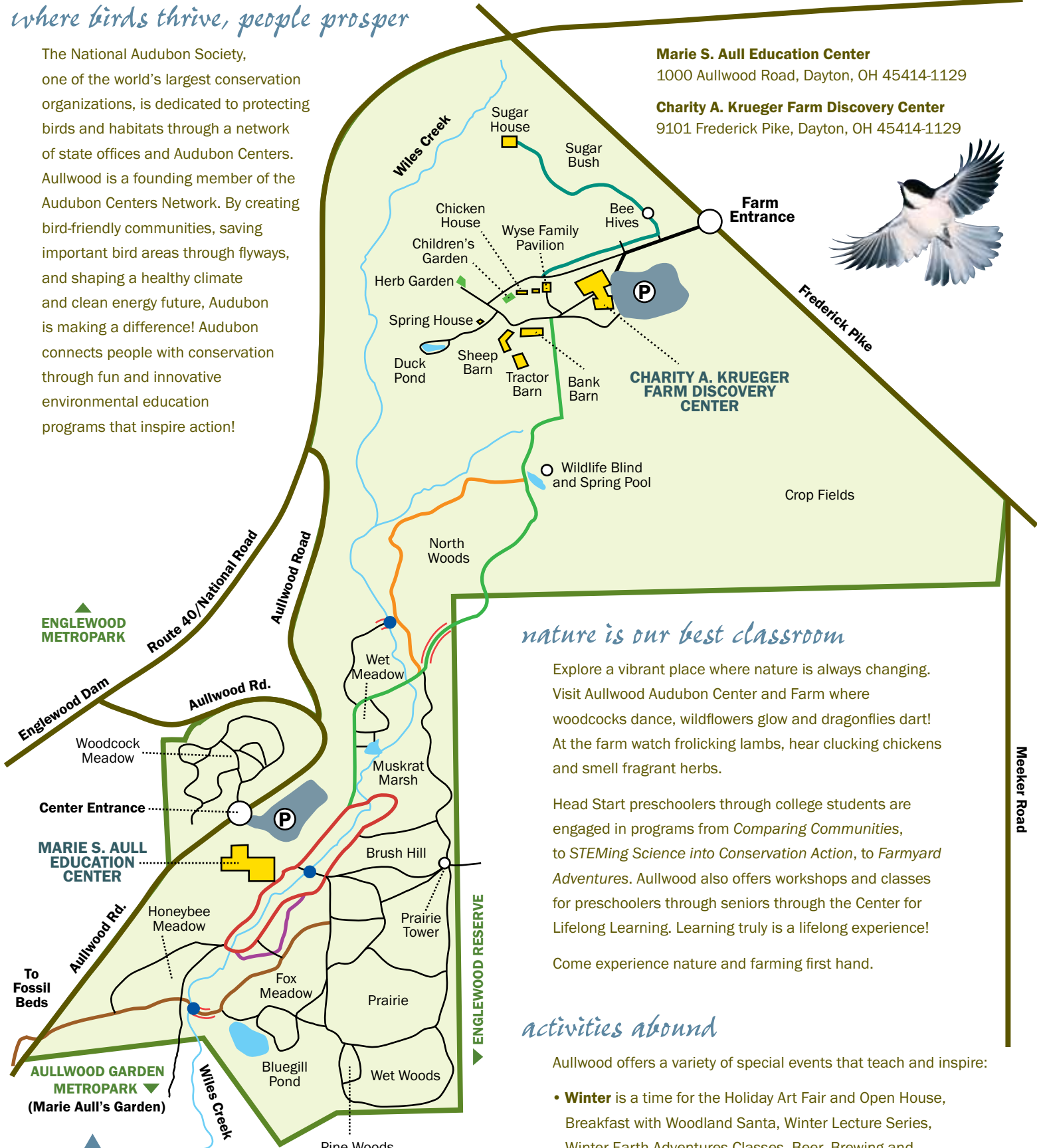
