Bird Study Merit Badge

Learn all about binoculars and how to properly use and clean them. You will also discover how to complete a field notebook and identify six types of wing feathers. Be able to listen from your window at home and identify who's singing that song!

Meets all requirements except 8


Animal Science Merit Badge



Would you like to get up close and personal with some real, live farm animals? Then you're in luck! Meet many different kinds of livestock during your visit, including chickens, cows, goats, horses, sheep, and more! You'll learn all about livestock from their breeds, digestive systems, diseases, and dietary needs. You'll also learn about careers and how livestock are a vital part of America's food chain. Come experience your inner farmer!

Nature Merit Badge



Are you a fan of Ohio's wild plants and animals? Now you can get to know them even better! Meet live animals, learn about food chains, discover eight species of birds and be able to identify venomous snakes! Get your hands dirty when you collect soil samples and be able to identify types of wild plants. You'll go home knowing more about nature than ever before!

Meets requirements 1, 2, 3, parts of 4.


Wilderness Survival Merit Badge



Love to "rough it" in nature? Then you need the skills to make sure you can survive in the great outdoors. Spend eight action-packed hours learning about first aid, shelter, water, firebuilding, and more! Put together a personal survival kit and learn how to use a signal mirror. Cost is \$15 per person for this special class (min. \$100 total). Choose either one 8-hour session or two 4-hour sessions.

Aullwood is only twenty minutes from downtown Dayton, and a five-minute drive from the Dayton airport.



Directions:

From I-70, take Airport Access Rd. exit 32. After about a mile and a half, take the US-40 exit toward Englewood/Vandalia. Turn left on W. National Rd. (US-40). To reach the farm, turn left on Frederick Pike; the farm will be on your right. To reach the center, turn left on Aullwood Rd.; the center will be on your left.



Aullwood Overnight!




